Day 1, Sunday 7th June: Outbound travel

On completing our pick-ups we travel north west to Chester.

Making a stop at National Trust's **Dudmaston Hall** in Shropshire en route, we aim to arrive at our hotel in central Chester in the late afternoon.

Day 2, Monday 8th June: Port Sunlight

After a leisurely breakfast we travel to the Wirral and the **Port Sunlight Village**, built by the Lever Brothers in 1888 to house workers in its soap factory.

We have a village tour with a guide followed by some free time to visit the museum and the **Lady Lever Art Gallery** before returning to Chester.

Day 3, Tuesday 9th June: A Fab day in Liverpool

Travel the short distance to **Liverpool** where we have a guided tour by coach which will take in **Strawberry Fields** and **Penny Lane**, besides the city's two main Cathedrals. Afterwards there will be time to spend around the **Albert Dock** where you will find **Tate Liverpool** before we take our **Ferry across the Mersey** to Birkenhead to meet our coach. Return to Chester.

Day 4, Wednesday 10th June: Bodnant Garden & North Wales Coast

We head into North Wales today for a visit to the National Trust's beautiful **Bodnant Garden** where we take lunch. Return to Chester in the afternoon via the North Wales coast, stopping off at the popular seaside resort of **Rhyl**.

Day 5, Thursday 11th June: Free day in Chester (Driver's day off)

Today you have the full day to explore this beautiful Roman city. Take a tour around the Roman remains and amphitheatre and explore 2000 years of history, visit the stunning Cathedral, or take an sightseeing cruise on the River Dee. Further afield, Chester Zoo is accessible by bus from outside the hotel.

Day 6: Friday 12th June: Llangollen and the Pontcysyllte Aqueduct

Today we visit lovely town of **Llangollen** where we have time to look around the Country Market or to discover the story of the **Llangollen Heritage Railway**. In the afternoon we travel to nearby **Trevor**, where we join our 45 minute charter trip across the **Pontcysyllte Aqueduct** before returning to Chester.

Day 7, Saturday 13th June: Homeward bound

Return to Bicester, making a stop at the **Trentham Estate** en route for lunch. ETA back at Bicester in the early evening.
